Deployment to clinical area: For ALL loaner devices, follow the steps below when a device is taken from the loaner pool and placed into clinical service.

- 1. Ensure device readiness including PM status and all parts present.
- 2. Complete all the fields in the Loaner Tracking sheet located at the loaner storage area.
- 3. Inform personnel in clinical area and Evening Shift Team Leader of loaner device status.

NOTE: For devices that have clinical alarms, default settings, or require accessories, refer to the Model-specific Loaner Exchange Procedure on the Biomed website for detailed instructions when placing the loaner into service.

Return to Loaner Pool: For ALL loaner devices, follow the steps below when returning a loaner device from clinical service to the loaner pool.

- 1. Perform any required maintenance or cleaning to ensure device readiness for next deployment.
- 2. Enter the return date in the Loaner Tracking sheet located at the loaner storage area.
- 3. Inform personnel in clinical area and Evening Shift Team Leader of loaner device status.

NOTE: For devices that have clinical alarms, default settings, or require accessories, refer to the Model-specific Loaner Exchange Procedure on the Biomed website for detailed instructions when returning the loaner device to the loaner pool.
